Agenda No. 4: Review of Faculty Recharge Programme

(a) Seminar / Conference / Workshop / FDP / SDP (organized by HIT under TEQIP-II):

- Already organized during Apr-Aug-2016 = 14 Programmes (including one National Conference and five Faculty Development Programmes)
- Already planned during Sep-Jan-2016-17 = 07 Programmes (including one National Conference and two Faculty Development Programmes)

Most of the departments, in turn, have been organizing / will organize such programmes on wide ranging and relevant topics.

The 2-day National Conference on Renewable Energy in Jul-2016 attracted around 160 participants. The 3-day National Conference on Recent Advances in Science and Technology planned in late-Sep-2016 is expected attract between 200 to 250 participants.

(b) Seminar / Conference / Workshop / FDP / SDP (participation from HIT under TEQIP-II):

- Already attended during Apr-Aug-2016 = 24 Faculties (including nine International programmes)
- Already planned during Sep-Mar-2016-17 = 36 Faculties (including 22 International programmes)

Faculties from across multiple departments have been participating / will participate in such programmes. A number of them also have presented / will present papers in such programmes.



Agenda No. 5: Review of Publications and Research

The Head (Research) is about to start an initiative by Sep-2016 for compiling and publishing a report on R&D activities at HIT that will list out all publications, research projects and consultancy activities by the HIT faculties. This report is expected to be published by Nov-2016. Subsequently, a repository of copy of all these publications is also scheduled to be set up by Dec-2016.

Agenda No. 5: Review of Outreach and Partnerships

- (a) Industry-Institute Interaction Programmes (organized by HIT under TEQIP-II):
 - Already organized during Jul-Sep-2016 = 07 Programmes
 (including one 30-day Industry-oriented Special Training
 Programme organized by the Training and Placement Office [TPO])
 - Already planned during Nov-Dec-2016 to nominate between 10-15 faculties to take part in industry forum like INFOCOM and/or Initial Learning Programmes (ILP) conducted in-house by industry leaders like TCS
- (b) Industry Visit Programmes (organized by HIT under TEQIP-II):
 - Already organized during Mar-Aug-2016 = 15 Visits
 - Already planned during Sep-Dec-2016 = 05 Visits

Most of the departments, in turn, have been organizing / will organize such visits, mostly within the state, to a diverse range of industrial establishments.
