# Agenda No. 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the Last IQAC Meeting

The minutes of the eighth meeting of the IQAC held on 29-May-2018 were confirmed.

# Agenda No. 2: Review of Recruitment Activities for Jul-Dec-2018

Based on the requirements provided by the various departments / sections, the recruitment activities were reviewed and duly approved. It was decided to review the same again during the IQAC meeting tentatively scheduled to be held in Jan-2019.

#### Agenda No. 3: Examination Results Review

The IQAC Coordinator informed that the results of the Even Semester Examination 2017-2018 were discussed in detail in two phases – during the 14<sup>th</sup> AC Meeting held on 09-Jul-2018 (for B Tech 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Semester plus M Tech 4<sup>th</sup> Semester) and during the 15<sup>th</sup> AC Meeting held on 31-Jul-2018 (for B Tech 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>

Semester, M Tech 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester plus MCA 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Semester) – and were approved after due deliberations [refer to Agenda No. 5 of 14<sup>th</sup> AC Meeting and Agenda No. 3 of 15<sup>th</sup> AC Meeting]. The results were brought out in this fashion to give priority to the B Tech and M Tech Final Year students passing out as well as to the B Tech 1<sup>st</sup> Year students in view of the Special Supplementary Examinations scheduled to be completed by mid-Aug-2018.

### Agenda No. 4: Curriculum Design / Revision

The IQAC Coordinator informed that the AICTE Guidelines compliant revised curriculum (Course Structure for entire programme and Detailed Syllabus for 1<sup>st</sup> Year) for the following programmes, effective from Academic Year 2018-19, were published on the HIT Web-site on 25-Jul-2018, before commencement of the B Tech 1<sup>st</sup> Year classes:

- B Tech AEIE, BT, CE, CHE, CSE, ECE, EE, IT, and ME
- M Tech -AEIE, BT, REEN, CSE, ECE, and VLSI

The above-mentioned curricula are based on reviews / recommendations made by the respective Boards of Studies (BOS) for all the degree-awarding departments that were presented during the 14<sup>th</sup> AC Meeting held on 09-Jul-2018 and were approved by the Council after due deliberations [refer to Agenda No. 4 of Minutes of 14<sup>th</sup> AC Meeting].

### Agenda No. 5: Examination Results Processing Automation

The IQAC Coordinator (also the Deputy Controller of Examinations) informed that the detailed requirements gathering for the proposed custom-built automated Examination System had to be postponed until Jul-2018 due to significant and substantial changes in existing curriculum structure (introduction of Honours Papers and some form of Choice-based Credits). As a result, the detailed requirements are expected to be finalized by Aug-2018, and the trial run of the same is tentatively re-scheduled to Nov-2018 so that the system can go live only after the Odd Semester Examinations 2018-19 are over.

### Agenda No. 6: Implementation of MAKAUT's Mandatory Additional Requirements

The Dean (Student Affairs) briefly explained how the existing faculty mentorship system will be extended to implement, in a systematic manner from Aug-2018 onward, the tracking and monitoring of all B Tech students for accumulation of activity points in line with the MAKAUT Notice regarding Mandatory Additional Requirement for earning B Tech degree through Activity Points to address needs of industry and society.
