The action taken report (attached as <u>Appendix-I</u>) was presented and the Council approved the same incorporating the following change suggested:



# Agenda No. 3: Consideration of the Results of: (a) B Tech 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Examination 2015, (b) B Tech 4<sup>th</sup> Semester Examination 2015 (for Lateral Entry Students), and (c) M Tech 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Examination 2015

The summary of results, compiled by the Controller of Examinations (COE), was presented in PowerPoint form (attached as <u>Appendix-II</u>) by the Chairman of the Council. After due deliberations, the results were approved by the Council for necessary ratification by the BOG.

In this context, the following possibilities were talked about:

- (a) To introduce, from next year, a new set of supplementary examinations based on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester results for 1<sup>st</sup> year B Tech students, following a round of 2-3 weeks of remedial classes, and within a month of beginning of subsequent academic year (in addition to the existing supplementary examination for B Tech 4<sup>th</sup> year students)
- (b) To adopt online examination system for supplementary examinations to minimize administrative and/or logistics overhead



- (c) To tag campus-based placement assistance with class attendance record for students to encourage more regular attendance possibly resulting in lower failure rate in examinations
- (d) To introduce, some subject-specific well-monitored mentoring mechanism by concerned Faculty Members for failing students
- (e) It was suggested that the COE should compile a note on modified examination rules for supplementary examinations for consideration of the Council's review / approval / recommendation in light of points (a) and (b) above
- (f) It was suggested that the Council convene a special meeting to discuss only matters pertaining to improvement for failing students and conduct of supplementary examinations in light of points (c), (d) and (e) above

#### Agenda No. 4: Miscellaneous

It was approved by the Council that Dr A R Ghosal, Director, Development Consultants Pvt. Ltd. would replace Mr Sukheshwar Mondal, General Manager (Operations), Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd. as Member of the Board of Studies in Chemical Engineering department.

There being no other item in the agenda, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
