- XV. If the Awardee is applying forlicensing of their Project IP, it will be necessary for themto inform SRISTI.
- XVI. The Awardee may apply for funding support to other agencies including BIRAC, under intimation to the Supervisor/Guide, SRISTI and BIRAC.
- XVII. If the Awardee has any parallel funding support, or they are in collaboration with any other funding agency-the terms and conditions of the collaboration will have to be shared clearly with SRISTI before execution of this ALA. The Awardee cannot avail support from two funding agencies for the same task/project at the same time. The BIRAC-SRISTI GYTI Award/Appreciation Awards hall has exclusive deliverable though it may be part of a longterm research work.

#### General to all teams:
