Restricted Entry of Automobiles

Landscaping

- 1. Plantation and greeneries are one of the key areas of concentration of the Heritage Campus. The nursery measuring about 30,000 sft to nurture saplings is maintained devotedly by the garden team. As on date the campus is having 623 planted trees of 15 feet (average) height and 160 trees of above 30-50 ft height. This should be the endeavor of each member of this institution to maintain, nurture and improve the concept of greeneries and landscaping. Horticulture supervisor to ensure following points while maintaining the same:-
 - (a) Hedges planted all around the campus to be maintained regularly to retain greeneries round the year. Appropriate and time to time trimming, removal of unwanted bushes etc. should be taken as a continuous process.
 - (b) Timely action to be taken to ensure appropriate seasonal flowers and overall beautification for all the seasons.
 - (c) The garden team should be ready to participate in various National/State level competitions in various categories like seasonal flowers, vegetables, indoor plants, herbal plants, Palm and feature garden designing etc.
 - (d) It is to ensure that a source of water is available for each plant planted inside the campus.
 - (e) Plantation by selected visitors with appropriate name cards to be ensured as and when required/directed.
- A holistic approach to maintain greeneries and make a beautiful campus should be one of the prime concerns of each member of the Heritage family.




