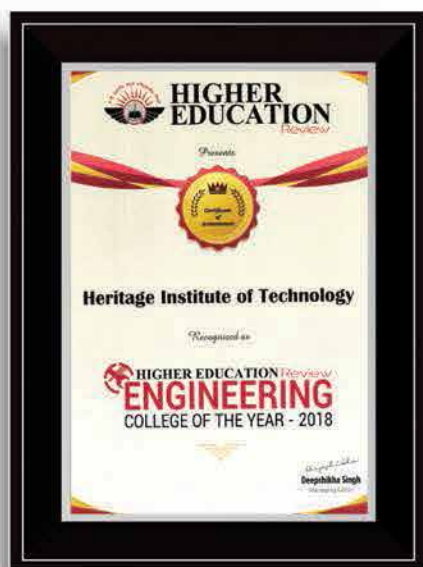

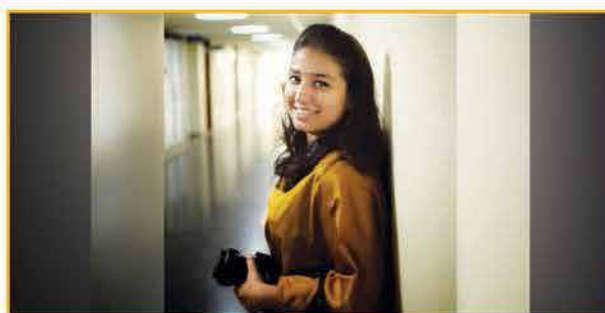

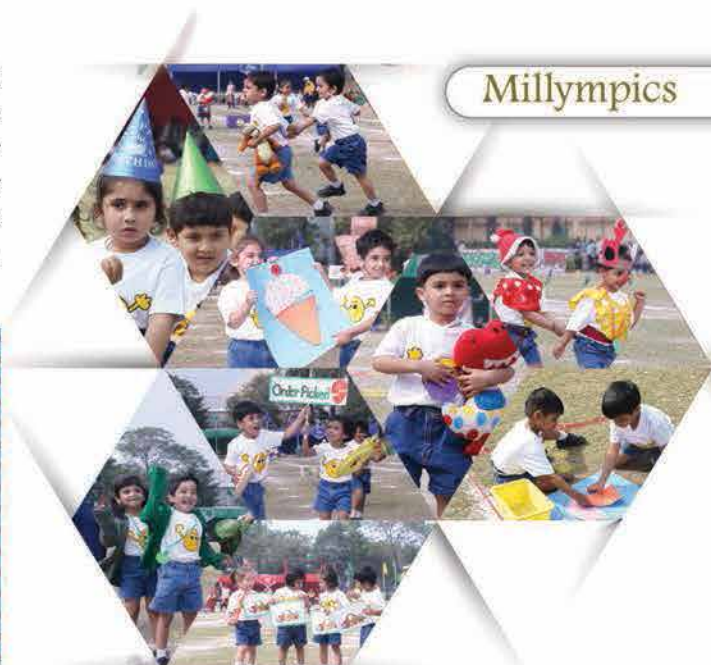

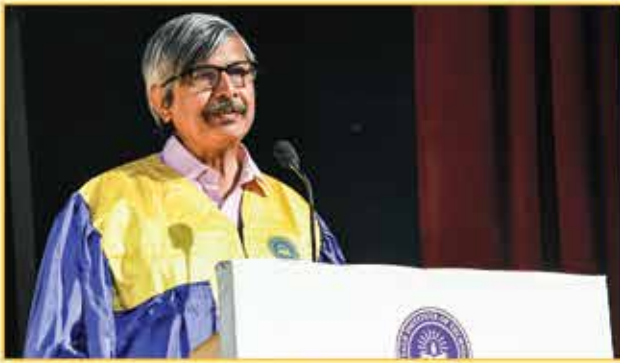

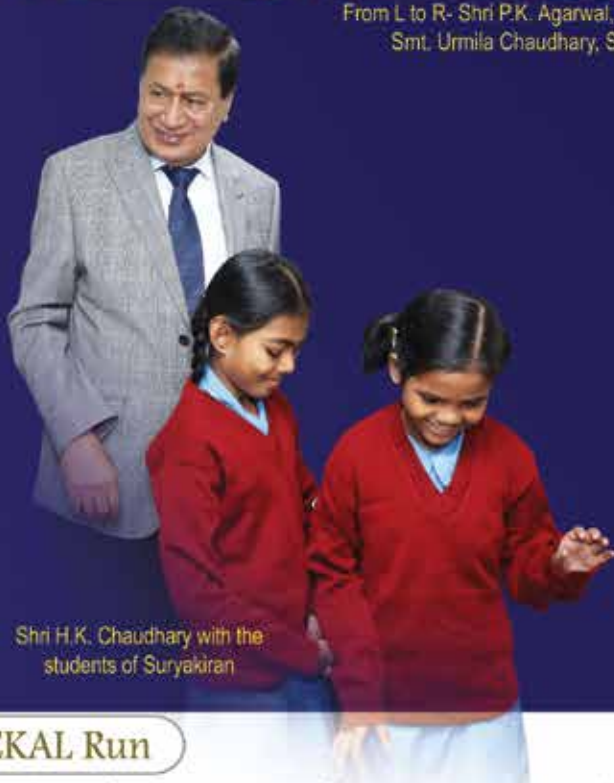

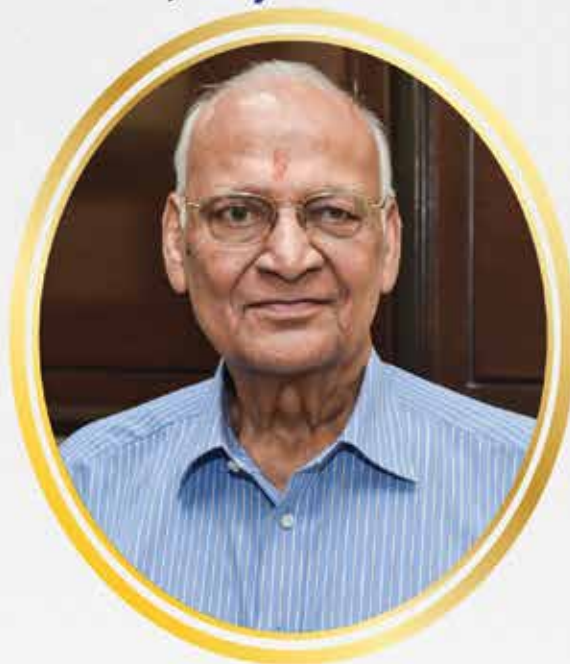
Rotaract club @HITK
