### Research Policy

The institute started its journey in the year 2001 with the objective of producing Graduate Engineers who will be the real manpower in the manufacturing industry. Gradually there was a shift in the objective: not only production of graduate engineers, but also production of new knowledge was felt to be the priority. A Research Policy of the Institute was subsequently adopted.

The Research Policy Statement of the Heritage Institute of Technology stated the following:

The Members of the Faculty will undertake research and consultancy work so as to expand the frontiers of knowledge in their respective area. Faculty members who have still not completed their Ph. D. research work should complete them as soon as possible. Consultancy work of the industry should be taken up with an eye to improve the performance. Research should be innovative and out of the box as much as possible. A separate research cell will be opened up in future for providing guidance to the members of the faculty. Considering the need of the country at a specific time, research policy will be revised. Heritage institute of technology will focus on need-based research. In order to achieve the goal, members of the faculty will be encouraged to visit local industries and get acquainted with the processes and products being practiced. Identification of the problems in the processes and products and finding solution will help MSMEs to grow.

Other than tapping local industry, submission of project proposals to different State and Central Government agencies will be encouraged. Minor and Major research projects funded by the UGC, AICTE, other projects funded by the State and Central DSTs, DBT, ICMR, etc., will get focused attention.
