#### Agenda Item No.9: Annual Report 2014-2015

The soft copy of Annual Report 2014-2015 as circulated to the members of the BOG was approved.

#### Agenda Item No.10: Miscellaneous (Placed on the Table)

(i) Teaching Assistantship for PG students admitting during Academic Session 2016-2017 from TEQIP-II fund:

In order to attract more PG students for admission to M.Tech. courses, it has been proposed to provide Teaching Assistantship to all non-GATE 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> year M.Tech. students during the Academic Session 2016-2017 from TEQIP-II fund @ Rs. 12,000/- per month till completion of TEQIP-II programme subject to availability of fund.

BOG approved the same.

(ii) Interim Policy for formation of Students Council 2016-2017:

Election for formation of Students' Council for the year 2015-2016 could not be held because of a notification issued by Govt. of West Bengal in view of Assembly Election. Also for last few months the Institute witnessed unrest amongst two groups of students which resulted in several complaints and counter complaints from these students against each other and also at UGC Anti-Ragging Helpline.

In the prevailing circumstances, in order to maintain peace and harmony in the campus it is proposed that the Student Council for the Academic Year 2016-2017 will be formed by Class Representatives nominated by the Principal as per following guidelines.

#### 1. Policy for nomination

- 1.1 Each B.Tech. and MCA class (Department-wise / Yearwise / Section-wise having an approved intake of 60) would have one representative in the Students' Council, nominated by the Principal as a Member of Executive Committee. There shall be one representative from all 1<sup>st</sup> year M.Tech. class and one representative from all 2<sup>nd</sup> year M.Tech. class in the Students' Council as member of the Executive Committee, nominated by the Principal.
- 1.2 For a student to be nominated by the Principal as Class Representative in the Student Council the following criteria shall be followed

P. My

(i) For 2<sup>nd</sup> year, 3<sup>rd</sup> year & 4<sup>th</sup> year B.Tech. classes and 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> year MCA classes

The student must have a minimum attendance of 80% and a minimum YGPA of 8.0. A merit list of Top 5 students will be made and the Principal will offer the position of CR in order of merit. If all 5 (five) shortlisted students declines to accept the post of CR, then Principal will have the authority to nominate 1 (one) student from that class.

- (ii) For 1<sup>st</sup> year B.Tech. classes a merit list would be prepared on the basis of Class XII results and the Principal will offer the position of CR in order of merit. If all 5 (five) shortlisted students decline to accept the post of CR, then Principal will have the authority to nominate 1 (one) student from that class.
- (iii) 1 (one) CR from all 1<sup>st</sup> year M.Tech. students and 1 (one) CR from all 2<sup>nd</sup> year M.Tech. classes and 1 (one) CR from 1<sup>st</sup> year MCA class will be nominated by the Principal.
- 1.3 Executive Committee of the Council would be formed by the nominated Class Representatives.
- 1.4 After formation of the Executive Committee, all other activities like distribution of Portfolios, Fund Management, meetings, working of the Council shall be governed by the existing constitution of the Students' Council.

#### 2. Tenure

The tenure of the nominated Executive Committee shall be for a period of 1 year from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 30<sup>th</sup> September.

The BOG approved the same.
