- 4.1 In National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2020 by Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Government of India, Heritage Institute of Technology has been ranked **154** amongst Engineering Universities and Institutes (considering both Government and Private) in the country.
- 4.2 The Institute has proposed five slots of date for NBA Expert Team visit regarding new accreditation of UG programme in ME and yet to receive a reply from NBA Office, New Delhi.
- 4.3 The Institute submitted its application to AICTE for Extension of Approval of all UG & PG courses for the Academic Year 2020-2021 and also applied for starting of two (2) new programmes (i) Bachelor of Design (B.Des.) with 30 intake and (ii) B.Tech. in Computer Science and Business Systems (CSBS) with 60 intake.

The Institute presented various documents before the Scrutiny Committee of AICTE at the Eastern Regional Office, AICTE, Kolkata and now awaiting for Expert Visit Committee. But due to Lockdown for COVID 2019 and as advised by AICTE, the Institute has submitted all relevant papers online and has also uploaded data in the AICTE webportal.

4.4 The Institute submitted various information to AICTE during the period under report.

- 4.5 As the Participating Institute (PI) of WBJEEB 2020 e-Couselling, the Institute submitted the basic information as per the prescribed format to WBJEEB 2020.
- 4.6 The Institute had been awarded as the 'Most Preferred Engineering Institute of the Year-2020 (East)' at the 13th ASSOCHAM Higher Education, Livelihood and Skills Conclave. The award was handed over to Principal of HITK & DGM, Heritage Group of Institutions by Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey, Union Minister- Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India.
- 4.7 The Institute has uploaded filled Data Capture Format (DCF) for the AY 2019-2020 successfully on AISHE portal on 13.03.2020.
- 4.8 Suspension of classes: As advised by the Govt. of West Bengal as well as MAKAUT, WB on 14.03.2020, the Institute suspended classes during 16-31 March, 2020 to combat spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19). It was further extended three (3) times till 17th May 2020 as advised by Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal and Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India.

However, online classes (Theory, Practical & Seminar classes) and other academic activities continued till the syllabus for each paper was covered.

- 4.9 The 3rd year students were instructed to do Summer Training/Internship during the lockdown period and the students were instructed to do so in online mode.
- 4.10 The students are enthusiastically doing courses on Coursera which have been made free for this summer as a special offer by coursera authorities if the students register through HITK.
- 4.11 The Institute will follow the revised academic calendar recommended by UGC and AICTE.
