5.1 Extension of Approval (EoA) for the Academic Year 2022-2023

In response to our applications on the web portal of AICTE:

- EoA has been obtained for all existing BTech, MTech and MCA programmes of HITK. Intake capacity for the Department of Renewable Energy has been reduced from 18 to 9.
- The new UG programme in Computer Science and Engineering (Internet of Things and Cyber Security including Block Chain Technology) has been given approval with an intake of 60.
- Our application for reduction of seats in PG programme in Computer Science and Engineering from 36 to 18 has also been approved.
- 5.2 NAAC Accreditation (Cycle 2)
 - Heritage Institute of Technology has been accredited with 'A' grade, having CGPA of 3.13 on a 4-point scale. This CHAIRMAN'S accreditation will remain valid for a period of 5 years from 12 July 2022.

- 5.3 MAKAUT-WB Digital Inspection of the Institute
 - A panel of experts from MAKAUT-WB conducted a digital inspection on 21 June 2022 for introduction of a new BTech programme in Computer Science and Engineering (Internet of Things and Cyber Security including Block Chain Technology) with an intake of 60.
 - The same panel considered proposed reduction of seats from 36 to 18 in the MTech programme of the Dept of Computer Science and Engineering.
- 5.4 Even Semester Examinations 2021-2022 & Publication of Results

2022 PASSING OUT BATCH STUDENTS

Placements for the 2022 batch are tapering off now with 140 companies having already completed or initiated their placement drives so far, although more companies keep approaching from time to time.

Eight hundred and thirty students have already received over 1,400 offers among themselves. Of these, 400 students have received multiple offers (some as many as 5 offers each).

Some of the highlights of this batch have been:

- Over 750 offers from Large IT recruiters (Cognizant, Wipro, TCS)
- Over 230 offers from consultancies like Capgemini, PwC and EY
- 32 offers from Young Optics, Taiwan
- Over 30 offers from Core Industry (including JSW, Tata Advanced Systems, Reliance Retail, Godrej, Dematic, Himatsingka, Grindwell Norton, Dorf Ketal, MN Dastur)
- Over 70 offers from the EdTech industry
- Nearly 200 premium offers (above 6 L) from large and niche recruiters
- "Super offers" from Google (3), Amazon (18), Microsoft (2) as well as PhonePe, JusPay, Clumio, Dukaanetc.

2023 PASSING OUT BATCH STUDENTS

Placements for the 2023 batch started even while they were still in their pre-final year. TCS and Infosys both ran their Hackathons in the first quarter, which lead to job offers as well. A female student from CSE reached the global Top 30 of TCS CodeVita, becoming the only female Top 30 this year.

TCS has already conducted their first wave of National Qualifier Test-(NQT) from end-June and has already made 220 offers (including offers from CodeVita). More offers are expected from the second wave currently in progress. Infosys also launched their premium offer recruitment which is also in progress.

Among the top-end recruiters, Goldman Sachs and Amazon had already selected 2 of our students for their summer internship, which they are about to complete and hopefully receive PPO for these Super Offers.
